Our Topic this term is 'Fire' What will we be learning?

English:- This half term we will be learning about the alphabet, common nouns, adjectives and segmenting and blending words. Developing independent writing using the visit to the fire station. The children will write recounts and letters. To link with our topic we will be using stories about dragons as a stimulus for writing.

Maths:- Using previously learnt skills e.g. doubling to help the children answer addition questions. Learning to tell the time. Recognising the value of coins. Number and place value skills will continue to be developed.

Geography:- Use fieldwork and observational skills to create simple maps of routes from school to the Fire Station. **History:-** Investigating similarities and differences in houses from the past to present day. **P.E. :-** Learning the skills to play games. **SEAL:-**'Relationships' Children will develop an understanding of how to deal with their feelings without hurting others. **Science:-**We will be learning about different types of materials and carrying out a simple investigation. _____
