*Our Topic this term is 'The United Kingdom'
What will we be learning?*

English:- This half term we will learning about question marks, how to write questions and write an answer. The children will be learning how to correctly sequence and write a set of instructions. Information about Queen Elizabeth will be used to develop writing skills.

Maths:- Counting and ordering numbers to 20 and beyond. Learning what is meant by 'half' of a shape, a measurement and a number. The children will be learning how to count in two's, fives and tens. They will be doubling numbers. Learning how to equally group/share items and write the corresponding number sentence.

Science:- Identifying materials and why they are used to make certain items. **Geography:-** Identifying the countries that make up the UK and putting them on a map. **History:-** Identifying old and new buildings and comparing the types materials used in them. **P.E. :-** A professional coach from 'Derwentside School Sports' will be working with the children during curriculum time to develop their skills to play tag rugby and tennis.
